

Tips for Using the Student Guide

- ✓ When you print these guides, be sure to set your printer on two sided copies, flipped on the short edge.
- ✓ Make sure that you have enough time to see all of the exhibits. An hour and a half or more is recommended to get the most out of your visit.
- ✓ Divide students into groups and assign each group a different page to focus on. Have groups get together and share their answers when they get back to class as a review.
- ✓ If students are having difficulty finding answers, remind them to read the graphics and to look out for key words such as “In a Kelp Forest”, to help direct them towards the correct answer. In addition to the chaperone guide, the volunteers in each gallery are also a valuable resource when searching for information.
- ✓ Remember that these guides are to supplement and enhance the student’s visit to the Aquarium. The main goal should be exploring the exhibits, searching for information and discovering new things, not answering every question in the guides.
- ✓ Most of all have fun, relax and enjoy learning along with your students!
